Your contributions to our parish help maintain the facility, making it the center of prayer in our community. Last year, I sent you our State of the Parish Report, which provided detailed information about how we are working to grow support for our faith community and facilities. It highlighted that over the last three years, we updated and completely remodeled the rectory kitchen,

removed the stage from the social hall and added a beverage station, put air conditioning/heat pumps in the church and a dehumidifier in the social hall, and had a newer and bigger organ donated to the church. This year we added a new entrance from the parking lot directly into the social hall in time for the centennial celebration.
